Stipend, Housing and Travel Costs***

2009 Stipend:

Stipend is \$5,800 for the 10 week program. This stipend is subject to state and federal taxes. Students must have a method for direct deposit to a bank or credit union of their choosing. Relevant banking information will be required on the first day of the program.

2009 Housing:

Housing will be made available to those who require housing near the University of Maine research site, subject to approval by the NSF REU project director. The housing cost will be paid for by the NSF grant. There is no food allowance.

2009 Travel:

Travel costs of up to \$350 for travel to/from the University of Maine are reimbursable, subject to approval by the NSF REU project director. Students must present receipts for reimbursable expenses.
